A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 280-10 OF CHAPTER 280 OF THE PORT JERVIS CITY CODE PERMITTING THE COMMON COUNCIL TO WAIVE FEES WHICH HAVE PREVIOUSLY BEEN SET, ESTABLISHED OR AMENDED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL

1. <u>Purpose and Legislation</u>. From time to time, for good cause or reason, the Common Council has been asked to waive fees set, established or amended by the Council set forth in Chapter 280 of the Port Jervis Code or elsewhere within the Code. The Common Council may waive any such fees previously set, established or amended by a majority vote of the Council upon proper request for waiver based upon an appropriate or equitable reason or reasons as determined by the Common Council in its sole discretion from time to time.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE TO THE EXTENT THAT THIS LOCAL LAW MAY CONFLICT WITH APLICABLE PORTIONS OF THE GENERAL CITY LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, IT IS THE STATED INTENTION OF THE CITY TO EXERCISE ITS AUTHORITY TO SUPERSEDE AND AMEND, AS GRANTED UNDER THE MUNICIPAL HOME RULE LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, SECTION 10. THE CITY HEREBY PROVIDES NOTICE THAT IT IS EXERCISING ITS AUTHORITY TO SUPERSEDE AND AMEND PURSUANT TO MUNICIPAL HOME RULE LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK SECTION 22.
