A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 535-47
OF CHAPTER 535, ARTICLE XI CHANGING THE
OFF STREET PARKING REQUIREMENTS FOR
RESTAURANT USES FROM ONE PARKING SPACE
PER 150 SQUARE FEET OF FLOOR AREA TO
ONE PARKING SPACE PER 150 SQUARE FEET OF
OCCUPANT LOAD AREA

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this legislation is to change the requirements of required off street parking spaces for restaurant uses within the City of Port Jervis to account for areas of restaurants used for kitchen, storage or dining areas. The intent is to require parking spaces based upon the floor area in dining areas to be used as occupant load area.
- 2. <u>Legislation</u>. A Local Law amending Section 535-47 of Chapter 535, Article XI changing the off street parking requirements for restaurant uses from one parking space per 150 square feet of floor area to one parking space per 150 square feet of occupant load area.
