Director's Report -

April 15, 2013

DPW Committee Meeting:

1. Water Plant raw water pump funding:
 - a) \$90,000 is the amount that is to be used from the 2009 bond
 - b) The same amount will be removed from the 2013 bondDiscussion held on financing.
Frank clarified 2009 bond issues, related to financing the pumps.
2. The \$34,000 plus check from our rebate on the solar project will hopefully partially fund the emergency sewer pump.
3. Tri-states light update (Temp fix to the wiring)
4. Issue with O&R in regards to the banner on Pike St. with regards to the wind and their poles.
Discussion held by several members concerning installation of guidelines for stability of pole.

5. Possible hydrant removal on Orange St. Chief was notified.
Referred subject to Fire Chief and Fire Committee.
6. Opticon sensor at Main St. and Jersey Ave. has been repaired and is awaiting installation by Pantel Electric.
7. Dump truck to Mahagamack Cemetery for a clean-up

Old Business –

1. Stan had a resident complain about side walk damage at the fire on Myrtle Ave.
2. Concern about litter behind the ally way and tracks behind Tech-N-Flex, needs to be cleaned up.
3. Mike McCarthy thought the Rec. Dept. could help with the clean-up.
4. Bob Richie received a complaint about litter along the tow path in D&H Walkway.
5. Mike McCarthy asked the sweeper on West Main Street and Erie (all Streets to be done in First Ward).
6. Kelly - discussion on tree stump removal at Middle School.
7. George - O&R patches on West Main Street need to be fixed up(Pike to Park)
8. Rob – Warren and Maiden Lane shoulders to be repaired, due to damage from plows.
9. Frank – discussion held on man power needs for maintaining properties that the city is responsible for.

New Business –

1. Frank – Questioned who blacktopped the new nail salon on Jersey Ave. Jack stated that the city was not involved.
2. Rob –
 - a. Jersey Ave will need to be patched where the sewer line break occurred, road surface very rough.
 - b. Questioned a water leak on Maiden Lane and Irving.
Jack stated that it was a valve and it will stop eventually.
 - c. Discussion held on meeting schedules and time allowed at each meeting.

3. Carl thought the DPW should look at scheduling the meeting separate with all the projects coming up.
4. Kelly –
 - a. Questioned the status on the Promenade Project. Jack stated that the process is still on going.
 - b. Tree commission to plant 100 trees, discussion held on donated trees to be planted at City Hall.
5. Mike – Resident request to cut down trees at West End Beach. Discussion held, at this time the City is not in favor of this proposal.
6. Stanley –
 - a. Concerned about a parking space in front of City Hall on Sussex Street.
 - b. Requests the street sweeper to be down town before 7:00 am as well as in front of the local Dr.'s offices
7. Rob -
 - a. Questioned the status of the Beach Street Pump Station Project, Jack stated work to begin shortly.
 - b. Requested the status of the Spillway Repair Project. Jack stated that surveys are being done currently.
