Mr. Scott Quinn, of McGoey, Hauser, and Edsall Consulting Engineers PC briefly detailed the Library's application for a 12-car parking lot. He spoke about handicap parking, guiderail, retaining wall, storm water, and lighting.

Mr. Quinn stated that he had spoken to the Orange County Planning Department and department heads regarding their comments and concerns. He also clarified that there was no proposed closure of the adjoining alleyway during construction.

Mr. Robert Burbridge requested a conditional use permit to open an auto repair shop at 116-122 Franklin Street. A site plan had not been submitted with the application, but Mr. Burbridge would be providing one to the Board shortly.

Mr. Kidney asked if any changes, such as the number of employees or hours of operation, would be necessary to the site plan. Mr. Burbridge stated that no changes would need to be made.

Mr. Vicchiariello asked if Mr. Burbridge was aware of the Fire Inspector's comments for this site. Mr. Burbridge noted that he had met with Mr. Reilly last week to discuss issues from the previous tenant.

Mr. Vicchiariello asked if the paint booth was still on site. Mr. Burbridge stated that the booth had been removed.

Mr. Kidney recommended the note on the previous site plan pertaining to the paint booth be modified to state the booth would no longer be used or the note be removed altogether.
