DPW Minutes Feb. 10, 2015

Meeting called to order at 6:02pm

Present Chairman Kevin P Cunningham, Director Jack Farr, G. Oney, R. Ritchie, F. Bell, R. Waligroski, Mayor Decker, & C. Hendrick

1. Ted Otteni and Jack attended the Orange County Transportation Council's meeting on January 20th, 2015 to discuss the funding and progress of the Tri-States Bridge and road widening project. Discussion on the need for more funding to complete the project.
2. Mrs. Linda Litchwich has a concern about darkness on her street and would like a street light added on the pole in front of her house at 114 Hudson St. DPW and PD will look into this concern. This needs Council Approval.
3. 2005 Dump truck transmission is broke and needs replacement. The cost of this is \$7500.00 and will take a big chunk of DPW repair line and it's only February.
4. The budget line for salt is taking a hard hit this year. These storms have been taking up a lot of material and we should seriously look at increasing the amount next year. This year's cost is \$88 per ton/treated.
5. The Tri State Bridge/ Road Widening Long Environmental Assessment Form is completed and is being reviewed. We are still making progress.
6. Promenade discussion:
 - A: Funding is capped at \$488,898 for construction and inspection
 - B: Construction is \$455,067 and Construction inspection is \$46,000
 - C: Construction Inspection has been used up a little because of re-bid and re-scope of job which leaves \$37,500 left for construction.
7. The clarifier project is moving on schedule with possible completion in late May.
