Just like many of our residents who pay taxes, I wasn't pleased with the proposed increase. I understood why it needed to be done but didn't like it. When the clerical error came up and the proposed budget went from 14.4% to 17.4%, I knew we needed to go back to the drawing board. The city charter does not allow the mayor to make changes, so I worked with our City Clerk Treasurer and Finance Chairman to find cuts that won't adversely affect the services we expect. We were able to find some savings in gas, electric and fuel as well as some other lines to bring the increase down to 8.9% for the councils consideration. Please understand further cuts will reflect on services and this proposal does not fund any projects nor does it add to the city's fund balance. The officers of the PJFD will also be sworn in at this time.


