The DPW crews have started and will continue to work on the new storm line on Pennsylvannia Avenue to try and rectify the flooding on Barcelow Street. (15 " HDPE style pipe).

DPW has been working continuously on the DEC Consent Order and we are making great progress on what is needed to comply with the order.DPW bought a Flow Monitor which will save us money; dishes inside manholes; recement manholes to prevent I & I. Kristin asked where money was coming from. Money comes from sewer fee.

No hydrant flushing this fall due to lack of rain and the low reservoir levels. The valve at #3 has been shut off and to this date we have not heard a word from the neighbor down the road on Academy Avenue,

We are now prepping for winter weather by mounting plows and screening sand at the landfill property.

We have had further discussions on the EDPL Hearing and possible concerns with the traffic and possible 24 hour work on the culverts with one closing instead of two. Had meeting with O&R about moving poles. Property owner would be responsible for underground. Kristin mentioned about electric being made available in the Promenade Project for use by Tourism Board for events. She also mentioned a traffic problem at intersection of Orange, Reservoir and Charles Streets.

Regis mentioned a downed tree limb at 292 West Main Street.

Gina mentioned a tree fell on house at Hamilton and Canal.

Flashing Light Signs for wrong way traffic on Culvert Street will be installed soon.
