- Discussion with regards to the Capital Note items requested for 2018.  
No questions or discussion.
- Any and all updates from the DOT with regards to the Tri State Project and Sidewalk project. Go to bid in mid June 2018. 12 or 13 comments received from DOT. Mayor sent EMail regarding these.
- The Promenade street lights will again begin to be installed along with the benches and bike racks. We have no more black ones so switching to green ones. Black ones being ordered.
- The Josef Kucher Monument base will be poured in the next couple weeks along with the Flag Pole bases for the new Fireman's Park location on Pike St.
- As announced at the last Council Meeting, we will begin picking up yard debris citywide on Mondays for the foreseeable future. Remember that we will only be removing biodegradable/compostable bags or debris in garbage cans of less than 35 gallons.
- Discussion with regards to signage on Front St in the business district.  
2 hour parking Monday thru Friday 9 AM to 5 PM.
- Hydrant flushing will begin the week of April 6<sup>th</sup> and will continue for approximately 6 weeks. A list of approximate areas affected will be sent through NIXLE and posted on the City website. 3rd ward already started. Will advise residents by NIXKLE as to progress.
- Discussion with regards to the uniforms contract with the CSEA. The longer we let it lag the more it costs. One employee uses cleaning service. Lisa recommends going ahead with it. No objections from anyone.
