A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 220-9 AND 220-10B OF CHAPTER 220
OF THE PORT JERVIS CITY CODE CHANGING THE HOURS FOR
AUCTIONS CONDUCTED IN THE CITY OF PORT JERVIS,
ORANGE COUNTY, NEW YORK

1. Purpose. The purpose of this Local Law is to change the current restrictions on hours for auctions to be conducted in the City of Port Jervis. Chapter 220 of the Port Jervis City Code regulates auctions and auctioneers. This Chapter sets forth the requirements for auctioneer licenses and for auction sales, bonding, fees and hours. The purpose of this Local Law is to extend the days and hours for auctions within the City.

2. Legislation. Section 220-9 of Chapter 220 of the Port Jervis City Code is herein and hereby repealed in its entirety. In its place and stead, the following language shall be substituted as Section 220-9:

§220-9. Hours of Auctions. Auctions held within the City of Port Jervis shall not begin earlier than 8:00 a.m. and shall end no later than 10:00 p.m.

Section 220-10B of Chapter 220 of the Port Jervis City Code shall be amended so as to remove the words "Sundays and legal holidays excepted," in the second line of the current Section 220-10B of Chapter 220 of the Port Jervis City Code. As a result of this amendment, auctions may be held on Sundays and legal holidays in the City of Port Jervis.
