Public Works Committee Minutes-April 24, 2014

1. Call to order-6:00PM
2. Attendance-Mayor Decker, Frank Bell, Gerry Oney, Bob Ritchie, Carl Hendrick, Robert Walingroski, Interim/Asst Director Jack Farr.
3. Directors Report:
 - A. Bids advertised on 4/8, for the clarifier at the water filtration plant & returnable 5/8/14.
 - B. Bids advertised for Downtown Promenade on 4/16, & returnable 5/7/14.
 - C. Three new water pumps & VFD's have been installed at the water filtration plant with minor wiring to be finalized. Three old pumps may be processed for rebate.
 - D. Bids for 2 new dump trucks & spreaders came in approx. \$11,000 over budget; however, there are funds left over from the new sweeper & garbage truck in 2013 Bond (see below).
 - a. Sweeper came in @ approx. \$206,000 (leaving \$8,000)
 - b. Garbage truck came in @ approx. \$122,000 (leaving approx. \$23,000).

Discussion about need for new green T-shirts for employees @ a cost of approx.. \$1,000. Scrap metal can bsalvaged for cost. Also, noted old DPW & Police vehicles can be auctioned/scraped. (The following police vehicles are currently stored at the City's Water Filtration Plant Property and are currently surplus vehicles that are inoperable: 2003 Ford Crown Victoria- Vehicle does not have tires or rims. Must be removed via flatbed; & 1998 Ford Taurus- Overall exterior condition appears fine. Vehicle has engine and transmission problems).

- E. Discussed interviewing/hiring employees to replace positions lost in the street dept. due to advancements. To be continued.
- F. Banner in Tri-State came down in wind. Need to look at other options both here & Acre. Noted bucket truck is currently out of service.
