Public Works Committee Minutes August 18, 2014

1. Call to order-6:03PM

3. Director's Report

A. Tentative milling to begin 9/3-9/5/14 and paving to take place the week of Sept. 22nd for West Main St (From Mt William St to Pike St) Canal St (from W main St to Orange St) Sussex St (from E main St to Front St.)

B. FEMA (4020) basement reimbursement and appeal discussed. The city applied for just over \$124,000 and received only \$11,060.

C. Clarifier project at the water treatment plant was discussed. Pre-construction and notice to proceed meeting is tentatively set for August 27th. This will kick off the construction of the new Clarifier.

D. Water treatment plant algae issues and processing of water is slowly improving. The reservoir as of August 8th has been treated for the 3rd time. Raw water testing will be done to see the effectiveness of the treatment. The chlorine tank needs to be fixed or replaced due to wear cost \$1200-\$1400.

E. The new bridge lights have been installed and are operational. They are being paid at a fixed flat rate.

F. The water issue at 34 Church St. and 16 Barcelow St was discussed due to a problem of the two lines being tied together on one service line.

G. Salt prices are expected to rise approx. 27 percent. This will affect the budget.
