Registration for boys and girls in grades 3-6 for our 2016 season will be held on: Saturday December 5 from 9:00 am-12:00 pm, Sunday December 6 from 12:00 pm-3:00 pm and Wednesday December 9 from 6:00 pm-8:00 pm. **Registration will take place at the Youth Center on Pike St.**



Co-Ed Youth Basketball consists of an **instructional program** which takes place on **Saturdays** and a **basketball league (for 5th and 6th graders)** which will take place on **Wednesday evenings**.

The instructional program will teach the kids the proper fundamentals of the game of basketball. It will start on December 12th and will continue through March 5, 2016. **3rd and 4th graders will practice from 12:00 pm-1:15 pm and 5th and 6th graders practice from 1:30 pm-3:00 pm.** There is a \$35 registration fee per child (\$20 each additional sibling). The basketball league (for 5th and 6th graders) will be held during the months of January and February. ***The league is open to students in 5th and 6th grade.
