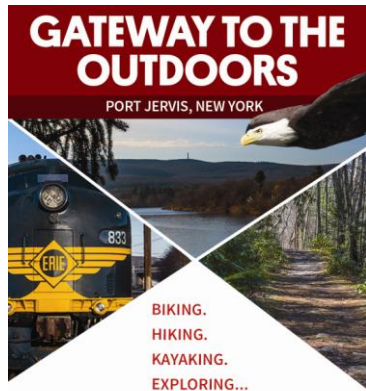

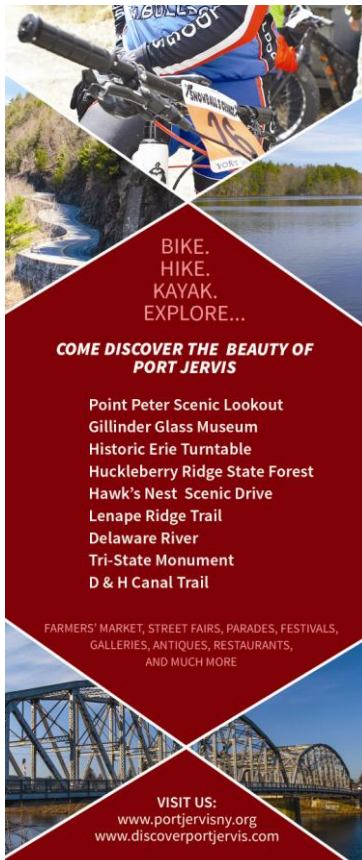

In June and very early July

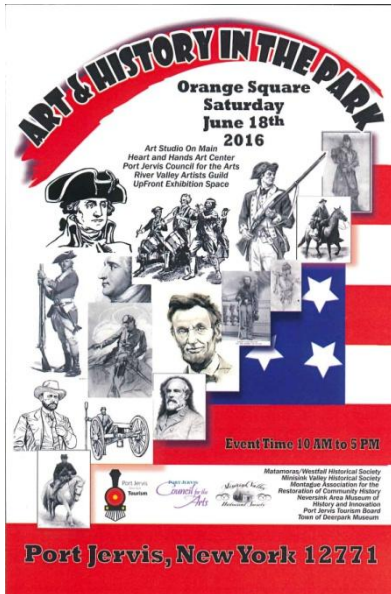
