1. Discussion on the Promenade and timeline.
Changes went to D.O.T. last week.
 - A. DOT review (3-4 weeks)
Must go back to bid after review
 - B. Bid Package
2-3 month process

2. OCTC Meeting and discussion on moving our E main St. construction money to 2016 and leave the money for the taking of property in this year's allotment.
Submitted changes to funding; asked for extension. Decision with Orange Co Transportation Comm. (I saw in Record over weekend Co. Exec. Put it in hands of David Church). Put in for needed funds.
3. Winter salt consumption discussion:

 - C. Yearly allotment
Increased from 400 to 600 ton; used 775 ton to date.
