Monthly Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order by Mr. Foster at 1820 hrs with Ms. Randazzo, Ms. Mann and Chief Worden in attendance.

Minutes: No Meeting held during month of December due to budget meetings.

#### General Report:

A 2017 year in review will be presented to the new committee during the February Police Committee Meeting.

The Chief reviewed preliminary statistics pertaining to 2017 Part I Crimes, Part II Crimes, Domestic Violence, Auto Accidents, Incidents and activities within the wards.

The Department is drafting an updated strategic enforcement plan and threat assessment.

Department has discontinued their crime mapping contract with Impact Computer Systems and is searching for a new vendor to provide crime mapping software.

Training Activities occurring for the new Year: CPR, AED, Bloodborne Pathogens, O2 Administration, Officer Survival Kits, Traffic Stops.

All sworn members were issued officer survival medical kits to be deployed in the field for emergency situations.

Too Good for Drugs Program update provided. The program was increased from 10 weeks to 15 weeks to incorporate both drug education and violence prevention education per request of the Middle School.

DARE Program is continuing in ASK Elementary School with approximately four weeks remaining of lessons.

An update was provided to various homeless interventions and outreach and plans to manage the wooded area adjacent to Riverside Park.
