1. Tri States road widening and bridge replacement project and time schedule.
 - Discussion with regards to Barclay Street making it a two way. No traffic on Minisink Avenue. Pole right in middle. Lines must be done on Barclay Street before being two way.
 - Water Main work and the need for an extension of road closures
 - Concrete work on the piers. Footings for temporary bridge will be done 2/5 or 2/6.
 - Flooding issues from the river delaying work
 - Temp bridge online the middle of April
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2. Parking lot paving bids discussion along with paving the road to Point Peter. Parking lot cost \$105,000. Point Peter cost \$100,000. One contractor will do each.

Bid with regards to the dog park fence. Ketcham fence \$15,000. 2 man gates. One drive in gate. Parking lot will be paved and lighted. Eventually acquisition of trains sitting there.
3. Violation with regards to water testing and the correction made at the water plant.
4. Discussion with regards to the DEC meeting in New Paltz and violation letter that was sent. The plans in violation were already completed by Carole Gallagher but never presented for approval to the DEC.
5. The Mini Mall repaving project will commence soon with the removal of the island along with the trees and yard hydrant. Catch basins will be rebuilt along with curbs and sidewalks on Ball St.
6. Tree work on the dams at reservoir three has ceased due to the weather and accessibility.



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7. The new DPW account clerk has started work in my office today. Thank you to Carol Gurliacci for accepting the transfer, she will be a big help to my office.
8. Discussion with regards to the Farnum House squirrel issue and the need for major repairs. Squirrels in the attic. Building needs serious work.
