

**DPW Meeting Minutes

**1. Tri Sates project Bridge/Road Widening  
update**

- **Temporary bridge is operational with no issues**
- **Original bridge demo is done and cleaned up**
- **Drainage work will continue. Catch basins being constructed in road widening area.**
- **Traffic control devices work will ramp up for Kingston Ave and Pike/Orange St in the next few weeks. Bagel Factory will get new sidewalk. Island in front of Homers will be moved over toward convenience store.**

**2. The Sidewalk Project is slated to begin May 13 with Phase 1 of the project with phase 2 and phase 3 to follow throughout the summer. Letters have been sent out prior to property owners in Phase 1 only at this time. Phase 1 will be southside of East main Street;right side of Hamilton Street and East side of Culvert Street.**

**3. The Mini mall Paving project paving has started and will hopefully be completed by**

**Tuesday the 7<sup>th</sup> of May. The line striping will take place on Tuesday with the lot opening immediately after the paint dries probably late in the day.**

- 4. The PT Peter Paving project has concluded and line striping will happen at trail crossings to warn drivers of hikers/bikers. Shoulders not built up yet. The entrance to the Elk Brox park from the old Kolmar is slated to be paved by O&R.**
- 5. Hydrant Flushing has ended until the fall season. Hydrants have run much cleaner due to the biannual flushing program. Also, the annual water quality report will be posted soon for the public to view. New hydrants cost \$3000 and reconditioning only cost \$1200-\$1300 so we will recondition hydrants.**
- 6. Training for the DPW was done for four of our employees for Bucket Truck safety. This training was done at the Town of Crawford DPW.**
- 7. West Main St. work will begin with manhole and catch basin rehab along with new ADA compliant handicap ramps on each corner.**
- 8. The Turntable Dog Yard fence will be installed at end of this week and will open when the Common Council sees fit. Topsoil ,seed and hay have also been installed.**
