

LOCAL LAW #8 OF 2019
A LOCAL LAW AMENDING §C9-11
OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF PORT JERVIS

Purpose. The purpose of this local law is to set the fees that City Marshals may charge private parties for their services.

Legislation:

§C9-11(A) of the Charter of the City of Port Jervis shall be amended to state as follows:

§C9-11 Employees: oath; bond

- A. The Marshals, collectively shall determine their rates, to be paid by the party requiring said services.
