-  Jack reported approximately 65 to 70 ADA compliant ramps were installed throughout the city on every corner.

Issues from Constituents

-  A gentleman who uses a walker could not get on the Dial A Bus outside the Salvation Army. The issue was the Salvation Army is on a hill and the Dial A Bus cannot operate its ramp in front of the store being on a hill. If any disabled person who needs to use the Dial A Bus, needs to contact DPW to make arrangements for them so there is a flat surface to get onto the bus.
